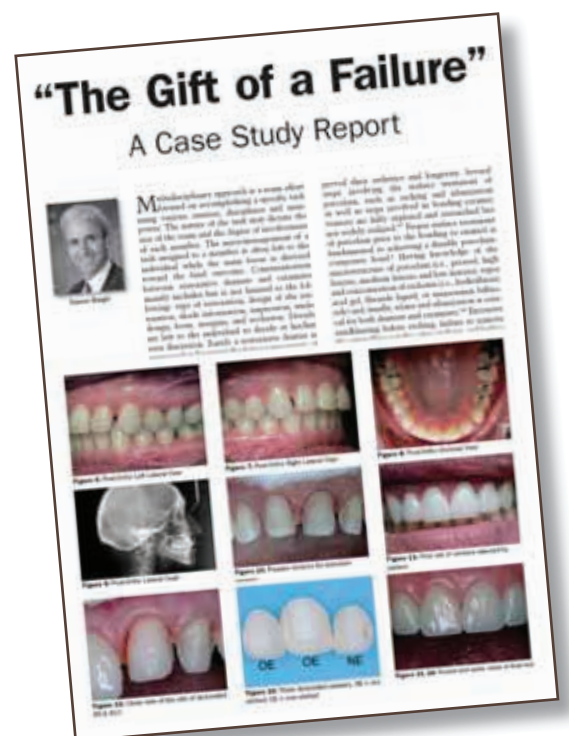


Bonded Ceramic Restorations in 2011 is an in-depth look at concepts and products developed during the last 25 years to enhance the durability of porcelain restorations.

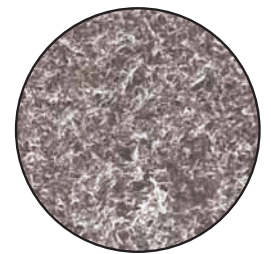

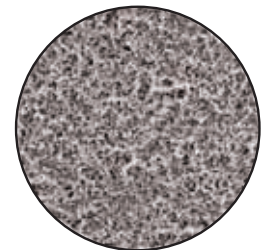

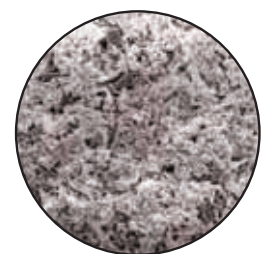
